The Crook County Foundation is excited to be celebrating it's 20th anniversary in our community. Since it's inception, the Foundation has provided a wide range of community programs, arts and culture, education, scholarships, and financial support.

As a 501(c)3 non-profit, our organization is able to act as a fiscal sponsor for programs who are not yet non-profits or simply have a project that they need to receive funds for. Through our support, the Paddy Pint Run, Crook County Cultural Coalition, and On The Move program have been able to grow and thrive.

This year also brought change to the organization. We brought on a new Executive Director, Brandi Ebner, after Daleena Green moved out of town. Brandi has deep roots in our community, as well as a diverse background with non-profit and event management. We are also under-going a Strategic Planning process, helping our board identify the best way to provide value and serve Prineville/Crook County.

This season, we have converted What's Brewing? into an evening only format and have already averaged over 60 people per presentation. We are expecting our largest Paddy Pint Run yet in 2019 with all the proceeds supporting local children and families. Our scholarships continue to expand as our committee looks for new ways to reach more students and encourage them to follow their dreams to career training or higher education.

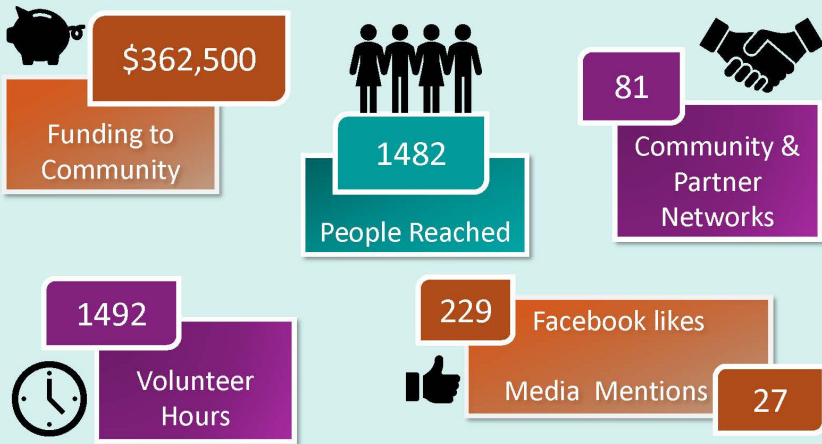
